## How Your Support of Dream Halloween® Helps

The Children Affected by AIDS Foundation (CAAF) is the only organization solely devoted to providing social, educational, recreational and other critical support programs to vulnerable children impacted by HIV/AIDS in the U.S. and other countries.

Through CAAF's domestic and international grant making program, we are one of the few resources focused on children and families for non-profit organizations in the United States, Latin America and the Caribbean. Our support offers a variety of programs and services including shelter, food, telephones, medical/respite care, long-term emotional support and guidance, and even a few days of outdoor fun for children affected by AIDS.

This year, CAAF launched our "Prevention by Intervention Program" for the reduction of mother to child transmission of HIV. Established first in Guatemala, this program will result in fewer children being born with HIV in a region of the world where HIV prevalence is climbing. CAAF plans to expand its work in this area as funding allows and establish programs in other countries within Latin America and the Caribbean.

Despite our expansion outside the U.S., CAAF's commitment to the domestic pediatric HIV/AIDS issue is stronger than ever before. This year our Family Assistance Program alone tripled in its support of children affected by AIDS.
